

Re: AV gas – MY experience with it.

Good gas. Won't hurt a thing to run it in any two stroke. Benefits? Not sure that there are any other than it will pass inspection at any NBRA boat race. I've run VP C-12 for years because it's just good ole gas that will pass inspection. I ran AV gas last October at the AOF Nationals because it's easier for me to get than the C-12 (closer to me) and my motor (44" Merc – modified Merc 500) ran as good as it ever has (very good!). I ran what I had left over in my fishing motors (diluted with some "pump gas" – I run a lot of oil in my race motors) – a 25hp 3 cyl. Yamaha and a 3 cyl. 50 hp Merc – and my weed eater. It didn't hurt them. The only thing that I have ever noticed about AV gas it that is *appears* to run a little lean (dry pipes) but I think that is just an optical illusion. I haven't changed my jetting in anything that I've run it in and everything ran just fine.
